Electric Vehicle Train the Trainer Program



- Highlighted in Governor Cuomo's 2020 State of the State, the EV Train the Trainer program has been included in the Excelsior Automotive Technician Task Force.
 - The five-day program will train instructors from each of SUNY's five automotive programs. Participants will provide the knowledge and skills to train technicians in their home regions.
- Entered into partnership with the government of Costa Rica to conduct EV Train the Trainer program for interested technicians in the Central American country.

Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Program



- Partnership with Glenmont Job Corps since 2017 to train students to become certified PV installers.
- Partnership with NYS Parks and Recreation to train individuals for Governor Cuomo's "Solar Energy Corps."

EPA Refrigerant Technician Certification Site

- Allows Hudson Valley to train and certify refrigerant handling technicians to prepare for the "Heat Pump Revolution" - the only practical technology to heat a building without using fossil fuels.
